**ORDER**

As you are aware, the Reciprocal Common Transport Agreements (Contract Carriage) was signed amongst the Government of Haryana, NCT-Delhi, Rajasthan and Uttar Pradesh, with the efforts of National Capital Region (NCR) Planning Board, on 14.10.08 as per which, all the Contract Carriage vehicles using clean fuel (CNG), conforming to prevailing Euro norms in NCR, and registered in NCR, were allowed to move unrestricted in NCR. The said agreement was notified by all constituent States of NCR.

2. As per the provisions in Para 5(ii) of Agreement, the agreement for 'Contract Carriage' was valid for next ten years (i.e. upto 13.10.18) or till such time new agreement is signed among the constituent states whichever is earlier.

3. In view of the above, requests were made to NCR participating states vide D.O. letter of even number dated 05.10.18 for agreeing the validity period of the prevailing agreement for another ten years.

4. That on the basis of a request letter dated 12.10.18 was sent by Chairman, CoTS to all the NCR participating States for the extension of validity of RCTA (Contract Carriage for further six months beyond 13.10.18, pending signing of new RCTA (Contract Carriage) and an order was issued in this regard on 16.10.18 extending the agreement dated 14.10.08 for a further period of six months (i.e. till 13.04.19). As the States requested for more time, agreement was further extended for till 13.10.19 vide Order dated 08.03.19.

5. Further, due to precautionary measures being taken to control spread of COVID-19, DoPT, Government of India issued OM dated 19.03.2020, 20.03.2020 and 22.03.2020, wherein all the departments/offices were asked to function with skeletal staff and work from home using electronic means of communication at all times. As it was difficult to hold a meeting on this issue and to avoid inconvenience to general public, the RCTAs were extended on the same terms and conditions for a further period of six months i.e. till 11.10.2020 of Contract Carriage and 20.10.2020 for Stage Carriage respectively or till further orders, whichever is earlier.

6. A meeting of CoTS through Video Conferencing was held on 15.09.2020 wherein it was unanimously decided by all NCR participating States that, to avoid inconvenience to general public, permits be extended on the same terms and conditions for a further period of six months i.e. till 10.04.2021 of Contract Carriage and 19.04.2021 for Stage Carriage respectively or till further orders, whichever is earlier.

7. Accordingly, it is directed that the terms and conditions of the agreement shall be abided and status quo be maintained by NCR participating States of NCRPB for another six months as detailed above or till further orders, whichever is earlier.
